The present revision is of the year 2020 and has been preferred against the impugned order being No. 4 dated 20.11.2020 passed by the Learned Sessions Judge, South 24 Parganas, Alipore, in Criminal Misc. Case No. 4335 of 2020, granting the prayer for anticipatory bail in favour of the accused/opposite party no. 2 in second application in connection with Baruipur P.S. Case No. 2856 of 2019 under Sections 376/417/325/506/509 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 and the State are present.

As none appears for the petitioner in spite of repeated calls since the date of listing, the revisional application stands dismissed for default.

All connected applications, if any, stands disposed of.
