We have considered the materials on record. Statements of witnesses implicate the petitioners i.e. in-laws of the victim housewife in the torture. Incident occurred within six months of marriage.

In view of the gravity of offence and prima facie involvement of the petitioners therein, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.
