We have considered the materials on record. No Fake Indian Currency Note (for short FICN) was recovered from the petitioner. His complicity has transpired from the statement of co-accused before a police officer which is inadmissible in evidence. Investigation is complete.

Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM (A) 115 of 2023 is disposed of.
