1. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the other co-accused persons have already been granted bail vide order dated September 12, 2023 in CRM(NDPS) 615 of 2023.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail.
3. However, in order to grant the benefit of parity to the petitioners, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioners as well.
4. Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 763 of 2023 is allowed, thereby granting bail to the petitioners on condition that the petitioners furnish bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge,

Special Court under NDPS Act, Jalpaiguri. The sureties may be common in respect of all the petitioners.

5. The petitioners shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of the trial court during the entire period of trial and shall attend the trial on each and every date.
6. The petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case so as to dissuade such person from disclosing such facts to any police officer or the court and/or tamper with the evidence in any manner whatsoever.
