1. It is submitted that there was a love affair between the parties. Victim has been recovered. He prays for anticipatory bail.

2. Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

3. We have considered the material on record including the statement of the victim. It appears that there was a love affair between the parties.

4. Under such circumstances we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

6. Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

7. The application being CRM (A) 936 of 2023 is disposed of.
