1. Report is placed on record.
2. We have considered the material on record. Petitioners do not have criminal antecedents. They are not the principal accused. Keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioners in the alleged crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
4. Petitioners shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application being CRM (A) 1000 of 2023 is disposed of.
