The Court :- This is an application for grant of probate of the last Will and Testament dated 31st January, 2018 left behind by the abovenamed deceased.

The son is the executor and the two daughters being the other heiresses in intestacy have consented to the grant. The husband of the testatrix died after the death of the testatrix but before filing of this application for grant of probate. The Will has been proved in common form by the affidavit of the attesting witness.
