The Court :- This is an application for grant of letters of administration to the estate left behind by the deceased.

The only son of the deceased is the applicant and the widow and the daughter of the deceased being the other two heiresses have consented to the grant.

Considering the view of the department upon complete scrutiny, the application for grant of letters of administration is allowed by granting order in terms of prayer (a) of the petition subject to the applicant furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 4,00,000/- with one surety.

The petition for grant of letters of administration stands disposed of, accordingly.
