The Court :- This is an application for grant of probate of the last Will and Testament dated 10th October, 2016 left behind by the abovenamed deceased.

The testator's mother predeceased him. The widow died subsequent to the death of the testator, but prior to the grant being obtained. Out of the two sons, one is the executor/applicant and the other son has consented to the grant. The Will has been proved in common form by the affidavit of the attesting witness.

Considering the view of the department upon complete scrutiny, the application for grant of probate is allowed by granting order in terms of prayer (a) of the petition.

The petition for grant of probate stands disposed of, accordingly.
