The Court :- I find from the earlier order dated 23rd March, 2017 that the matter is at a “pre-admission stage”.

The petitioner creditor is represented.

The Company is also represented.

In view of the amended provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the decisions in *Action Ispat and Power Private Limited-versus-Shyam Metalics and Energy Limited* reported in (2021) 2 SCC 641 and in *A. Navinchandra Steels Private Limited –versus- Srei Equipment Finance Limited and Others* reported in AIR 2021 SC 1180, in my view this Court does not have any jurisdiction to entertain this matter. There is no irreversible situation which has arisen warranting this Court retaining this proceeding.

In view of the aforesaid, CP/571/2015 stands transferred to the National Company Law Tribunal, Kolkata.

The Department shall treat CP/571/2015 as disposed of insofar as the records of this Court are concerned.
