8/ 06.01.2023 This case has got a checkered history. The petitioners have challenged the promotion selection list prepared by the Department. This Court having found the selection list illegal and arbitrary quashed the same and a direction was given to consider the case of the petitioners by publishing a fresh select list. However, the opposite parties have preferred letters patent appeals challenging the said order passed by this Court and the Division Bench in L.P.A. No.206 of 2018 and other analogous appeals, affirmed the order of the Writ Court with a direction to the respondents to consider the cases of left out persons, as some of them have already been promoted.

Pursuant to order dated 11.11.2022, I.G.-cum-Chief Security Commissioner, Railway Protection Force, South Eastern Railway, West Port, Kolkata is present in the Court.

It has fairly been submitted by the Officer present in the Court that if any person has been left out, his case may also be considered in the light of the orders passed by the Division Bench as well as by this Court. The Officer further undertakes that the case of one Manoj Kumar Singh, who was petitioner in W.P.(S) No. 1427 of 2014 shall also be considered and he shall be compensated with a cost of Rs. 50,000/- along with promotion within a period of two weeks, if he has not already been promoted.

In view of aforesaid submissions, no contempt is made out and the same is hereby dropped.

This contempt application is accordingly disposed of.
