02. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned DSGI along with learned CGC, appearing for the Opposite Parties.
3. The present writ petition has been filed by the Petitioner challenging the order of dismissal dated 06.08.2022 passed by the Opposite Party No.4-Divisional Security Commissioner/RPF, East Coast Railway, Sambalpur Division, Sambalpur.
4. On perusal of the record, it appears that the order passed by the authority is an appealable order. Moreover, in the

impugned order, it has also been stated that the appeal lies to the Appellate Authority within thirty days from the date of order.

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the impugned order, however, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to approach the Appellate Authority along with an application for condonation of delay. In the event such application is filed seeking condonation of delay, the Appellate Authority shall consider the same liberally and, if genuine grounds are shown, the delay in filing the appeal be condoned and the appeal be taken up for hearing on merit.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
