Respective applicants-claimants, in all these applications, are seeking condonation of delay periods mentioned therein which appear to be caused due to their financial crisis.

The learned AGP strongly opposed the applications on the ground that there is also circulation delay. The

However, considering the statutory right of the applicants, the delay periods mentioned in all these applications, stand condoned subject to the condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid periods of delay and also for the delay in circulating the matters belatedly.
