**P.C.:**

1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to a statutory authority to exercise jurisdiction duly vested in it by law. Ironically, the representation is filed on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 and on the 12<sup>th</sup> day, this petition is filed on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2023.
