01. This petition is challenging order passed by the learned Sessions Judge, rejecting application below Exh.164 filed by the petitioner in Sessions Case No. 9 of 2011. By way of the application, the petitioner had prayed to the learned Sessions Judge that certain documents such as medical certificate etc. collected by the prosecution, those were not forming part of the charge-sheet. The petitioner, therefore, filed application producing documents before the Court.
