1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants are seeking condonation of delay periods mentioned in these applications, which appear

to be caused due to their poor financial condition.

3. The learned Counsel for the acquiring body in Civil Application No. 5661 of 2020 strongly opposed the application on the ground that, no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay period.

However, considering the statutory right of the applicants and for the reasons stated in the applications, the applications are allowed and the delay periods mentioned in these applications stand condoned, subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the periods of aforesaid delay.
