Per Court :-

1. The petitioner has put forth prayer clause B as under

:-

“B) By issuing writ of mandamus or any other writ or direction in like nature that, the Resp. No.3 to decide the complaints filed by petitioner dtd. 06.02.2022, 28.07.2022, 02.11.2022, 28.11.2022 and 01.12.2022 within stipulated period by appointing inquiry committee thereon and to take appropriate against Resp. No.5 to 9.”

2. The learned AGP places on record the copies of the communication dated 27.01.2023 by the Deputy Commissioner (Establishment), Office of the Divisional Commissioner, dated

25.01.2023, which is the order passed by the Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Aurangabad and dated 11.02.2022, which is the communication by the Deputy Commissioner (Establishment) to the Chief Executive Officer (five pages). The said compilation is taken on record and collectively marked as “X” for identification. It is informed that all deputations have been cancelled and the petitioner’s grievance has been redressed.

3. In view of the above, this Writ Petition is rendered infructuous and stands disposed off.
