1 Issue notice to the respondent. Learned APP waives notice for the respondent.

2 Present application has been filed for getting the delay of 3956 days condoned in filing criminal appeal. Applicant is the original accused No.1, who want to challenge his conviction in Sessions Case No.6/2009 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Shahada, Dist. Nandurbar dated 13.01.2012. The appellant has been convicted for the offence punishable

under Section 302, 324, 147, 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code along with nine more accused persons.
