PER COURT :

1. This application is filed for setting aside order dated 19th January, 2022, passed by the learned Registrar (Judicial).
2. By the said order conditional time was granted to remove office objections. Office objections were not removed within time. Hence, the Registration of Second Appeal was refused.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the applicants state that all the office objections will be removed within a period of two weeks from today.
4. For the reasons stated in paragraph no. 4 of the application, the delay in filing the application is required to be condoned.

Hence, subject to the applicant removing all the office objections within a period of two weeks from today, the application is allowed in terms of prayer clauses 'b' and 'c', which read thus :
