2. The present First Appeal is filed by the State. As per the earlier order dated 03/01/2023, this Court has granted four weeks time to furnish fresh address of respondent no. 1 to 3.

ORDER

It is also made clear that on failure on the part of appellant/State to furnish fresh address of respondent no. 1 to 3 within period of two weeks from today, in that event, the said First Appeal would stand abated against respondent nos. 1 to 3, as provided in Rule 6(2) of Chapter VII of the Bombay High Court Appellate Side Rules, 1960.
