3. We dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondent No.1 to take emergent steps for recovery pursuant to the Revenue Recovery Certificate issued by the 2nd Labour Court, Aurangabad (**Exhibit-B**) dated 18.03.2021 as expeditiously as possible and in any case within eight weeks.
