Per Court:

1. The petitioner has put forth prayer clauses 'B' as under:-

“[B] By issuing writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or directions in the like nature, respondents no. 3, Chief Executive Officer may kindly be directed to consider and decide claims/representations of the petitioner annexed at **EXH-C** in the light of circular dtd 28.06.2018 issued by respondent no.1, for changing the postings of the petitioner by opening the posts of compulsory vacancies.”

2. The learned Advocate representing respondent Nos. 3 and 4 submits, on instructions, that the representations put forth by the petitioner would be decided by the respondents within four weeks.

3. In view of the above, the petitioner is satisfied.

4. This Writ Petition is, therefore, disposed off.

5. Respondent Nos.3 and 4 should respond to the representations and convey the decision to the petitioner, on or before 30th April, 2023, in the light of the circular dated 28.06.2018.
