ORDER:-

1. Heard.
2. Issue notice to respondents. Learned A.G.P. waives service for all the respondents.
3. Heard rival submissions. The applicant is seeking condonation of delay of 1427 days in filing the appeal, which appears to be caused due to their poor financial condition. The learned A.G.P. strongly opposed the application on the ground that delay is not properly explained.
4. However, considering the statutory right of the applicant, the delay of 1427 days stands condoned subject to condition that the applicant shall not claim any interest for the said delay period.

5. The appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.

6. The application is accordingly disposed of.
