PER COURT:

1. The applicant prays for condonation of delay caused in seeking restoration of Civil Application (St.) No.2923/2023 in Review Application (St.) No.2771/2020.

2. I have considered the submissions of the learned Advocates for the respective sides, more particularly, the strenuous objection raised by the Respondent. The delay is of 329 days and considering the reasons cited, the same cannot be termed as being deliberate or inordinate.
