PER COURT :

Applicant has moved this application for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent Nos.2 to 8 in Crime No.0452/2020, registered with Kaij Police Station, Beed, for offences punishable under Sections 354-A, 307, 326, 324, 323, 143, 147, 148, 149, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.
2. Heard learned advocate for applicant, learned advocate for respondent Nos.2 to 8 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent – State.
3. Crime was registered on 29/10/2020. It is revealed during the course of arguments that, in the present crime, charge-sheet is filed on 24/12/2020. The case is numbered as R.C.C. No.33/2021 and on 19/01/2021 charge is framed. The matter is

posted for evidence now. Considering these subsequent developments, no useful purpose would be served by cancelling the anticipatory bail granted to respondent Nos.2 to 8. This Court is not inclined to entertain the application on merits. Application is, therefore, dismissed.
