**ORDER:-**

**IN CA NO.3442/2023 AND CA NO.3443/2023:**

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants in both these applications are seeking withdrawal of their respective amounts of compensation, which have been deposited by the Acquiring Body alongwith the interest accrued thereon. It appears that the Acquiring body in both the matters has deposited only 50% of the compensation amounts alongwith the interest.
3. This Court, in other connected matters has already permitted the applicants therein to withdraw the entire deposited 50% amounts of compensation.

4. In view of the same, the present applicants are also permitted to withdraw the entire deposited 50% compensation amounts alongwith the interest accrued thereon till date, on usual undertakings to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

5. The civil applications are accordingly disposed of.

**IN CA NO. 6816 OF 2021, CA NO. 6818 OF 2021 AND CA NO. 6820 OF 2021.**

Since the appellant Acquiring Body in both theses applications has deposited 50% of the compensation amounts, the applications are made absolute in terms of prayer clause (A) and disposed of.
