1. At the outset learned counsel for the respondent raised objection about tenability of the petition.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners substantially on the last of hearing as well as today the learned counsel for the petitioners was unable to satisfy the Court that criminal writ petition is maintainable in respect of the order passed under the provisions of Employees Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
