However, considering the argument of learned Counsel for the MSRTC, it is transpired that the MSRTC has deducted amount of around Rs.30,000/- towards the TDS. The learned Counsel for the MSRTC has also assured to pass on the TDS certificate to the claimants for the purpose of income tax refund.
