PER COURT : -

1. On 23.06.2023, we had passed the following order :

- "1. When this matter was called out on 22.06.2023, none appeared for the Petitioner. However, Shri Sikchi, the learned Advocate, informed that the cause of action has been redressed and the amount of Rs.40,000/- has been paid to the Petitioner by the contractor.
