The applicants are seeking condonation of delay of
261 days in filing this appeal, which appears to be caused due
to their financial crisis. The learned Counsel for Respondent
No.2-acquiring body strongly opposed the same on the
ground that the delay is not properly explained.

applicants, delay of 261 days stands condoned subject to the condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid period of delay.
