1. Heard rival submissions.

2. The applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 64 days, which appears to be caused due to their poor financial condition. The learned A.G.P. strongly opposed the application. The acquiring body though served, but remained absent.

applicants and for the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed and the delay of 64 days in this application stands condoned subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the period of aforesaid delay.
