PER COURT :

1. Heard the learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. The inquiry officer is present in the court. Mr. D.B. Thoke, learned counsel, on instructions of inquiry officer makes a candid and fair statement that notices were directed to be issued to the petitioner through the society.
