The applicant is seeking condonation of delay of 1150 days in filing this appeal.

The learned AGP strongly opposed the same on the ground that there is also circulation delay. Respondent-acquiring body, though served, but remained absent.

However, considering statutory right of the applicant, the delay of 1150 days stands condoned subject to the condition that the applicant shall not claim any interest

for the aforesaid period of delay and also for the delay in circulating the matter belatedly.

The appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objections if any.
