1. Learned counsel Ms. Shelke causes appearance on behalf of acquiring body.
2. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants are seeking condonation of huge delay of 7370 days, which appears to be caused due to their poor financial condition.
3. The learned AGP and learned counsel for the acquiring body strongly opposed the application on the ground that no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay.
4. However, considering the statutory right of the applicants and for the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed and the delay of 7370 days in the this application stands condoned

subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the period of aforesaid delay.

5. The appeals be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.
6. The applications are accordingly disposed of.
7. Refer the matters to Lok-Adalat dated 11/02/2023.
