1. By this application original petitioner is seeking restoration of Criminal Writ Petition No. 1158/2022. Perusal of the application shows that there was no intentional Act on the part of the present applicant in not carrying out the amendment as directed by the Court. In view of the conditional order passed by the Court the petition came to be dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents opposed the application.
