ORDER:-

IN CIVIL APPLICATIONS FOR WITHDRAWAL OF AMOUNT :

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants are seeking withdrawal of their respective amounts of compensation, which have been deposited by the respondent - Acquiring Body alongwith the interest accrued thereon. It appears that the Acquiring Body in all these matters has deposited only 50% of the compensation amounts.

3. The learned counsel for the Acquiring Body though opposed the applications on the ground that the Reference Court has granted exorbitant amount of compensation, but fairly submits that in other matters this court has allowed the applicants therein to withdraw 50% of the amounts of compensation.

4. In view of the same, present applicants are permitted to withdraw the entire 50% amounts of compensation alongwith the interest accrued thereon till date, on usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this court.

5. The civil applications are accordingly disposed of.

IN CIVIL APPLICATIONS FOR STAY :

Since the appellant Acquiring Body has deposited the compensation amounts in these matters as directed by this Court, the applications are made absolute in terms of prayer clause (B) and disposed of.
