3. The prayer of the petitioner seems innocuous. If he has filed certain applications pending trial, irrespective of their maintainability or otherwise, it is expected that some orders are passed on the applications without which permitting the trial to proceed would be injudicious.

4. We dispose of the writ petition by directing the trial court to pass appropriate orders on the applications filed by the petitioner, if those have not been already passed, and thereafter, to proceed with further trial.
