1. Heard the learned Advocate for the Petitioner.
2. The maintenance granted to the wife and the daughter, is 20.5% of the salary of the Petitioner. The law laid down in *Kulbhushan Kumar v. Raj Kumari*, (1970) 3 SCC 129 and *Kalyan Dey Chowdhury vs. Rita Dey Chowdhury Nee Nandy*, (2017) 14 SCC 200, would be applicable.
3. The learned Standing Counsel for the Union of India has raised a serious objection about the maintainability of this

petition.

4. The learned Advocate for the Petitioner desires to withdraw this petition and avail of a statutory remedy as is permissible under the Army Act, 1950.

5. After considering the above statement, **this Writ Petition is disposed off** as withdrawn on instructions.
