ORDER:-

1. Heard rival submissions. The applicant is seeking condonation of delay of 118 days in filing the appeal, which appears to be caused due to his poor financial condition. The learned A.G.P. as well as learned Counsel for the Acquiring Body strongly opposed the application on the ground that the delay is not properly explained.

2. However, considering the statutory right of the applicant, the application is allowed and the delay of 118 days stands condoned subject to condition that the applicant shall not claim any interest for the said delay period.

3. The appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.
4. The application is accordingly disposed of.
