ORDER :

Heard. The informant has filed an affidavit, stating therein to have settled the dispute. It is a matrimonial dispute. The settlement is by way of reunion. Both, the informant and her husband (applicant No.1) are present before the Court.

2. Since it is a matrimonial dispute, being settled by reunion, the Criminal Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (C). The Charge Sheet No.48/2022 dated 29/03/2022 in R.C.C. No.111/2022 filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Tuljapur in connection with Crime No.I-384/2021,

registered at Tuljapur Police Station, District Osmanabad for offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 323, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code are quashed.
