PER COURT:

2. Today, the learned Advocate for the Petitioner is not present before the Court and has entrusted the task of mentioning the matter to the learned Advocate Shri. S. N. Boiwar.

3. Stand over to 04/08/2023 in the 'urgent orders' category. If on the next date, the matter is not worked out, we would proceed to decide the petition without the assistance of the learned Advocate for the Petitioner.”

2. The learned Advocate for the Petitioner/Applicant submits on instructions that, he would withdraw the Writ Petition.

3. In view of the above, **this Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn** on instructions. Needless to state, **the Civil Application also stands rejected.**
