1. The learned senior advocate representing these petitioners relies upon the judgment of this court (Coram S.V. Gangapurwala and Shrikant D. Kulkarni, JJ.) dated 04.05.2021, in the matter of ***Raja Tukaram Shinde and others vs. State of Maharashtra and another*** (Writ petition No. 903 of 2020 and group of cases).
