1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants are seeking condonation of

delay periods mentioned in these applications, which appear to be caused due to their poor financial condition.

3. The learned A.G.P. as well as learned Counsel for the respective acquiring bodies, strongly opposed the application on the ground that, no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay periods.
