. The petitioner claims to be a tribal woman. She was a victim of
a crime. She has been acquitted. Moreover, at her instance, a crime

was also registered against someone else. The accused therein have also been acquitted. The petitioner herein claims compensation on account of her arrest and prosecution besides 13 days delay caused in registration of the FIR lodged by her and prosecuting the concerned with right earnest. In our view, the petitioner may approach the District Magistrate. Her claim, if any, shall be decided on its merits.
