PER COURT :

1. Mr. P.K. Nikam, learned counsel informs to have instructions to appear for respondent no.2 and files his *vakalatnama* and affidavit-in-reply across the bar submitting the order to have been complied with and would be complied with in terms of the directions issued by this Court. Learned A.G.P. also files affidavit-in-reply of Respondent No.1. Same are taken on record.

2. In the writ petition the learned A.G.P. made a statement that the meetings, as are required to be held as per the rules i.e. once in two months would be held. Based on the said statement, writ petition was disposed of.
