1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The respective applicants in all these applications are seeking condonation of delay periods as mentioned therein, which appear to be caused due to their poor financial condition.
3. The learned AGP strongly opposed the application on the ground that no reasonable cause is mentioned for condoning the delay. The acquiring body though served, but remained absent.
