ORDER:-

1. Heard rival submissions. The applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 742 days in filing the appeal which appears to be caused due to their financial crisis. The learned Counsel Mr. Anurag Sakolkar, holding for learned Counsel Mr. Soman strongly opposed the application on the ground that there is also circulation delay. However, considering the statutory right of the applicants, the delay of 742 days stands condoned subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid delay period and also for the delay in circulating the matter belatedly.

2. The appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objections.

3. The Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.

4. At the request of learned Counsel for the applicants, the appeal be placed before the next ensuing Lok Adalat.
