Heard rival submissions. The applicant is seeking condonation of delay of 409 days which appears to be caused due to his financial crisis. The learned AGP strongly opposed the application on the ground that there is also circulation delay. The Acquiring Body though served, but remained absent.

2. However, considering the statutory right of the applicant, the delay of 409 days stands condoned subject to condition that the applicant shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid period of delay and also for the delay in circulating the matter belatedly.

3. Appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.

4. Application is disposed of accordingly.
