2. By way of present applications, applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 572 and 580 days respectively caused in filing the appeals against the judgment and award passed by the Reference Court at Jalgaon in L.A.R. No. 370 of 2003 and L.A.R. No. 380 of 2003 respectively.
