Perused status report received from concerned Judge i.e. Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Bhusawal, in respect of the proceeding which is sought to be transferred in this petition i.e. Hindu Marriage Petition No.166 of 2019 filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act for restitution of conjugal rights filed by respondent.
